#### Call to Order

### **August Minutes**

### **Cypress Creek Renewables Project**

Mary Beth Bianconi from Delaware Engineering (acting on behalf of the Planning Board) reviewed the application for Site Plan Review and Special Use Permit dated June 21, 2017 for a project named Fallen Tree Solar. The project sponsor is Cypress Creek Renewables, LLC and is to be located on approximately 49.64 acres of land at 204 Murders Kill Road, Athens, NY, owned by Joseph Skiliba and leased by CCR. CCR proposes to construct an approximately 2,000 KW solar photovoltaic array using ground mounted panels in a fixed-tilt tracking configuration.

The application as presented was incomplete and will require further review.

#### Lead Agency for SEQR Review of project

A motion was made by Betty Cure and seconded by Bill Whitbeck to file a letter of intent that the Town of Coxsackie Planning Board will be the lead agency for a Type 1 Action under SEQR for the Fallen Tree Solar Project sponsored by Cypress Creek Renewables LLC. The motion carried with Joanne Conway voting no.
