

**TOWN BOARD WORKSHOP MEETING

June 30, 2022**

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Hanse at 6:00 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion to enter into executive session with attorney Rappleyea to discuss current and potential litigation was made by Patrick Kennedy seconded by Michael Veeder and duly carried.

At 6:22 pm a motion to come out of executive session and reopen the meeting was made by Patrick Kennedy seconded by Michael Veeder and duly carried.

Due to increased gun shootings around the world, County Administrator, Shaun Groden through Interim Director, Ken Brooks has requested cameras be installed at all County owned buildings and leased buildings, namely the Coxsackie Senior Center. The County would pay all associated costs and would be responsible for any damages incurred due to said installation. A motion to approve the installation was made by Michael Veeder seconded by Patrick Kennedy and duly carried.

A resolution was presented to increase mileage reimbursement. Pursuant to Resolution #23 of the Town's January Organizational Meeting, mileage reimbursement was \$58.5 cents as set by the IRS effective January 1, 2022. The IRS has since increased the rate to 62.5 cents per mile. On motion of Patrick Kennedy seconded by Michael Veeder and duly carried, the Town will increase the mileage reimbursement to 62.5 cents per mile while on Town Business effective July 1, 2022.
